



Broken home: economic instability

Broken home: uneven consumption






Broken home: social dysfunction
















60% decline in wildlife populations 1970-2016 67% decline projected by 2020

 "The earth is the Lord's" Psalm 24.1-2








2. A Fallen World





3. The Land of Promise

Colossians 1.15-20

- The Source of Creation
 - v.16 "By him all things were created."
- The Sustainer of Creation
 - v.17 "In him all things hold together."
- The Saviour of Creation
 - v.20 He is the one through whom God is pleased "to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood shed on the cross."

- ✓ His birth
 - "Peace on earth" Luke 2.14
- √ His life

"He got up and rebuked the wind and the raging waters" Luke 8.22-25

- √ His death
 - "all things" reconciled to God through the cross" Colossians 1.19-20
- √ His resurrection

The first-fruits of a new creation

✓ His future glory "all things in heaven and earth under one head, even Christ" Eph. 1.9-10





- Hosea 2:18-23 "a covenant for them with the beasts of the field, the birds in the sky and the creatures that move along the ground."
- Isaiah 11:6-9 "for the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea"
- Isaiah 65:17-25 "wolf and lamb ... lion and ox ... they will neither harm nor destroy ..."









